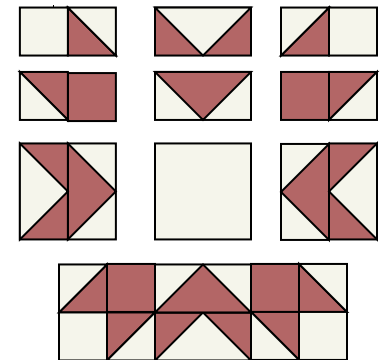
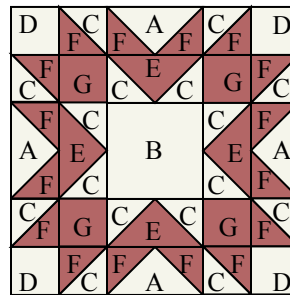
5" squares: Doris Goins - Solid colors (no black or white, please), all different
Ann Fordeck - Batiks

Cathy would like a 12" (finished) Memory block, made in two colors, a dark and a light, in Civil War fabrics of your choice.

Cutting: Light - A: (1) 5 1/4" square, cut in half twice on the diagonal
B: (1) 4 1/2" square
C: (8) 2 7/8" squares, cut in half once on the diagonal
D: (4) 2 1/2" squares

Dark - E: (1) 5 1/4" square, cut in half twice on the diagonal
F: (8) 2 7/8" squares, cut in half once on the diagonal
G: (4) 2 1/2" squares

Diagrams do not show seam allowances.



Jeanette would like a 12" (finished) Right Hand of Friendship block in Civil War fabrics.

Cutting: Light - A: (1) 5 1/4" square, cut in half twice on the diagonal
B: (4) 4 1/2" square
Medium - C: (1) 5 1/4" square, cut in half twice on the diagonal
D: (1) 4 7/8" square, cut in half once on the diagonal
Dark - E: (1) 5 1/4" square, cut in half twice on the diagonal
F: (1) 4 7/8" square, cut in half once on the diagonal

Diagrams do not show seam allowances.
