

# **Block and 5" Square Drawing Winners**

Please remember, when your name is drawn, get your preferences to Cindy Lash (email is on the front page) ASAP so that she can get the info into the next newsletter! Thank you!

<u>Blocks:</u> Nancy Peterson and Cathy Putman (see specifics below)

5" squares: Ardean Ebert—30s (prefer juveniles but will take any 30s fabric)

Gen Dornbush—Medium to medium dark bright batiks

Nancy would like a Disappearing Four Patch in two different 30s reproduction fabrics and either white OR white-on-white.

Cutting: Cut 5" squares: (2) white OR white-on-white (1) any 30s print

(1) different 30s print

Piecing: A. Piece into a four patch block. Press seams away from the background fabric in each pair and then press to one side after piecing all four together.

B. Measure 1" on either side of the center seams and cut to make nine separate block pieces.

C. Swap the top row/center piece with the middle row/left piece. Swap the middle row/right piece with the bottom row/center piece. Rotate the middle row/center piece 180 degrees.

D. Sew the pieces back together.










Cathy would like her block made from assorted red, blue, green, gold or brown prints, with a tan print for frame and sashing. Cutting: (9) assorted 1 1/2" squares from red, blue, green gold and/or brown prints for 9-patch A (2)  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " tan rectangles for B (2)  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " tan rectangles for C Four sets of (3) 2 1/2" squares from assorted red, blue, green, gold or brown prints for D (4) 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" tan rectangles for E Piecing: 1. Make a 9-patch from the assorted A squares. 2. Sew one B rectangle to each opposing side of 9-patch. 3. Sew one C rectangle to top and one to bottom of 9-patch. Square up to 5 1/2". E D 4. Sew together squares D and rectangles E as shown in diagram 4. D 5. Sew to 9-patch. Block should measure 9 1/2". Please do not square up. Е
