

Julie Kessler would like a 9 inch "Birds in the Air" block (also known as "Flying Birds")

Please use Civil War fabrics or similar and/or flowery. Small scale prints, please. The blue should be dark/navy blue, not royal blue, please.


Please do not square up! Note: There will be enough triangles to make two blocks.

Cutting: A: Dark blue/navy small scale print: cut 1 square 9 7/8" and cut once on the diagonal to make 2 triangles.

B: Different medium/dark small scale print: cut 3 squares 3 7/8" and cut each square once on the diagonal to make 6 triangles.

C: Light small scale print: cut 6 squares 3 7/8" and cut each square once on the diagonal to make 12 triangles.





#### 5" Squares

Kim Marti-Black and White Prints Becky Clark-Civil War - 2 lights and 2 darks

For a finished quilt of  $68\times82$ , you will need one phone book (120 6.5" squares/cut before class). At least 4 yards of various strings from  $\frac{3}{4}$  inches wide to 2 inches wide.

20 assorted  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares for cornerstones.

 $2\frac{1}{4}$ " yards of background fabric

Sewing Machine, basic sewing supplies
