Quilt Show and Competition, Saturday, October 7, 10am to 6pm

Perhaps you remember the quilt block contest and storefront quilt displays during the Apple Festival years ago? Well, they're BACK! Diann Scott is the new organizer for Historic Main Street Village; she asked Caroline and me to help get the word out. Caroline's Cottage Cottons will be the sponsor. We wanted to extend the invitation to participate to area quilt clubs.

This year's theme for the block contest is "Quilter's Choice." You may submit as many 12 1/2" unfinished blocks as you wish, any pattern, any fabric choices. The categories are: pieced, applique, mixed media, and embroidery. The deadline to submit blocks is September 25. Caroline's is the official drop off spot, but we will also be accepting blocks at the September 26th Noble Nimble Thimbles meeting. The blocks will be used to make a quilt to auction off next year.

If you have quilts to display for 20 days in the storefronts (care will be taken to avoid exposure to direct sunlight), call Diann to arrange for pickup and return (see phone number below).
