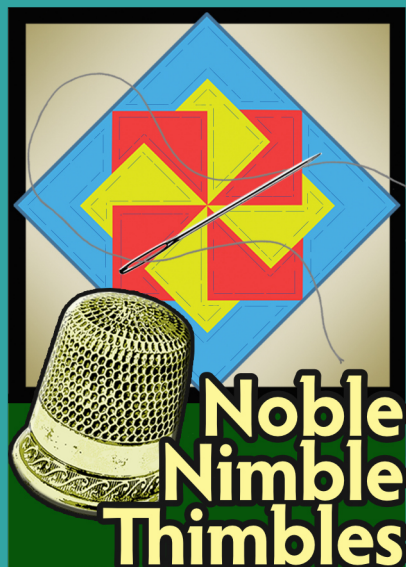

Set-up at 6:00; Shop at 6:30.

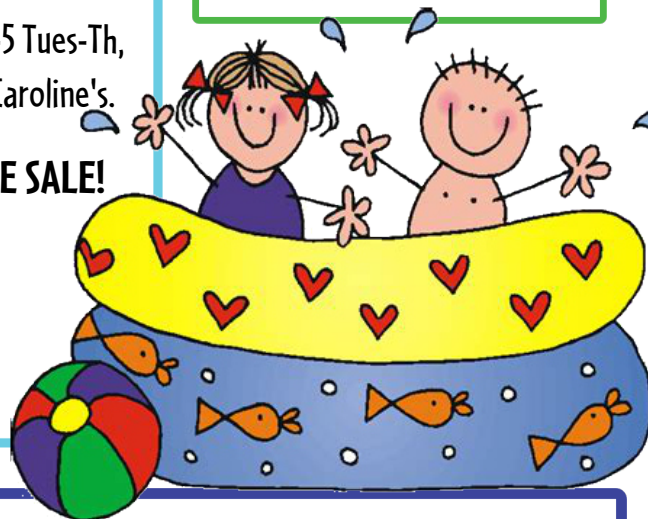
