Supplies Needed:

3-4 coordinating fat quarters
Matching thread
Fusible fleece or batting (10" x 12")
Sheer weight fusible interfacing (5" x 8")
Sew on snaps
Turning tool
(2) 13" pieces of 5/8" or 1/2" rick rack
Sturdy needle & thread
Hot glue gun
Templates will be provided with the pattern.

Gen would like a 6" Sawtooth Star block using white-on-white for the light and medium brights or batiks for the medium
No novelty prints, please.

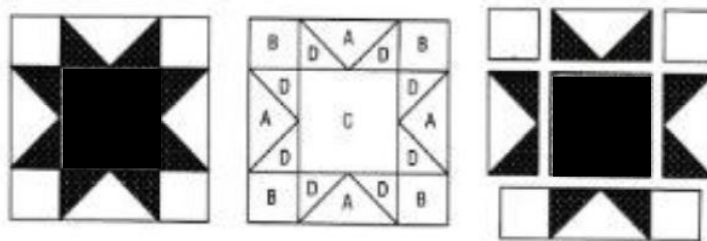
Cutting:

Light: A: Cut (1) 4 1/4" square and cut twice on the diagonal for a total of 4 triangles.

B: Cut (4) 2" squares.

Dark: C: Cut (1) 3 1/2" square.

D: Cut (4) 2 3/8" squares and cut once on the diagonal for a total of 2 triangles.



Note: Diagram does not show seam allowances.

Ann would like a 10 1/2" (unfinished) Lucky Stars block in brights and white or white-on-white. You can choose to use either one bright or two in your block.

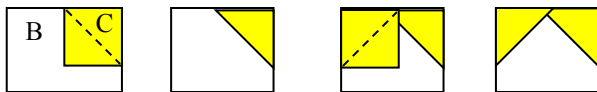
Cut: White (or white-on-white): A-(4) 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

B-(4) 3 1/2" x 4 1/2"

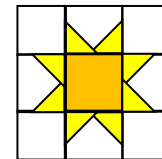
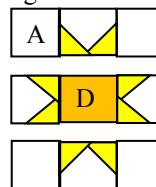
Bright: C-(8) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Bright (same or different): D-(1) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Sew: Mark a diagonal line on the back of the C squares. Stitch to B rectangles as shown below. Sew into rows and then sew rows together.



Stitch on line, trim & press toward bright.



PLEASE DO NOT TRIM BLOCK!
