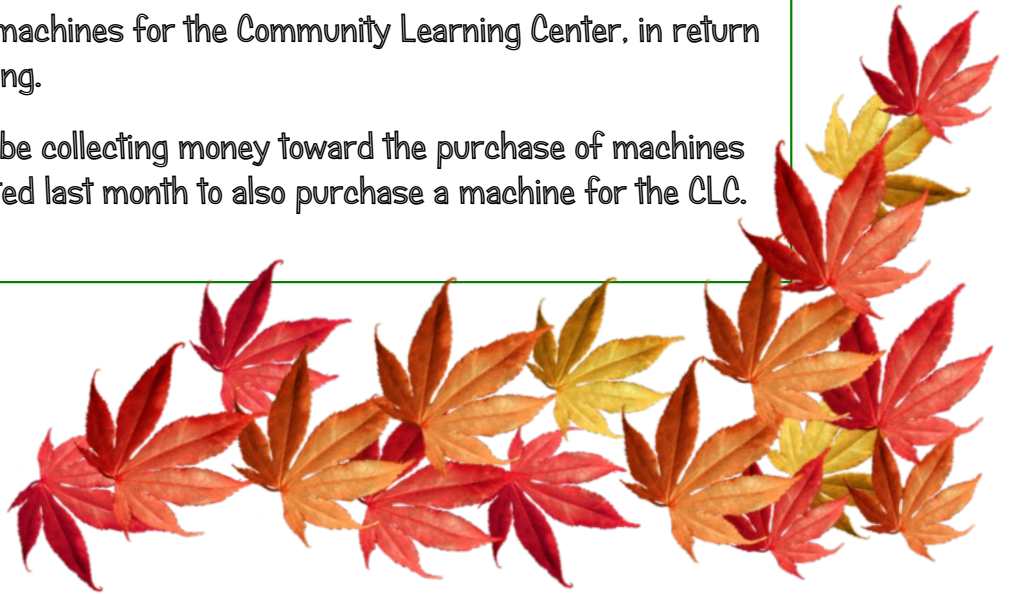
*Please stay home if you feel safer being away from group meetings. We will be in touch through our newsletter and our Facebook group page.*
