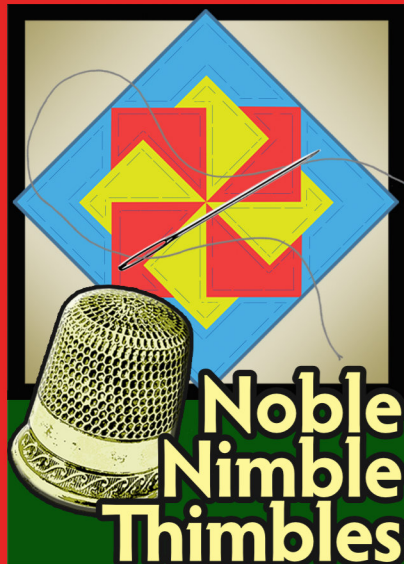

rotary cutter dowel rod seam presser
bead on scissors quilting sand board
binding tool June Taylor strip cut guide
walking foot embroidery machine
Acu-quilt cutter "Get a Grip" double thimble
graph paper rechargeable headlight
Kwik Klip for fastening safety pins
Double-edged razor blade for seam ripping
Clip clothes pin to iron seams by hand
Boning tool to press seams
Lace-edged milk glass dish to hold tools
Rubberized shelf liner to prevent slipping from your foot pedal, rulers, machine, etc.
Clipboard to keep track of stitches, patterns
